Academic Teaching and Research Option Licenses

NI Academic Software License Agreement

National Instruments (“NI”) is committed to providing cost-effective solutions for academic institutions. Your use of the SOFTWARE is governed by the terms and conditions of a separate Software License Agreement that was provided with the SOFTWARE (the “License”). Unless separately defined in this document, capitalized terms shall have the meanings set forth in the License.

This document is intended to describe the different types of Academic Teaching and Research Option Licenses that NI offers, including the maximum number of computers the SOFTWARE may be installed on under each license. The applicable terms stated herein are intended to supplement the terms and conditions stated in the License and shall in no way amend or otherwise modify the terms and conditions of the License. **INSTALLING THE APPLICABLE SOFTWARE ON MORE THAN THE SPECIFIED NUMBER OF COMPUTERS IS ILLEGAL.**

A use will be considered as one for “instructional purposes” if such use meets either of the following criteria: (i) a common exam is given to students at the end of a semester or other academic period and the exam relates (in whole or part) to the students’ use of the SOFTWARE or (ii) homework or similar projects requiring the use of the SOFTWARE are used for grading in lieu of an exam.

All licenses are perpetual (with the exception of the Student Install and Secondary School Options); therefore you have the right to use the software indefinitely, subject to the termination provisions in this Agreement. If you have purchased Software Service, you understand and agree that the support for the SOFTWARE will only continue for the amount of time specified in your purchase order for Software Service. After such time, you may continue to purchase Software Service at NI’s then current price, provided that Software Service is offered.

The license shall not be used for any commercial or industrial purpose. If your organization desires to use the license for a commercial purpose or other purpose not permitted under the scope of the License, you must enter into a separate license agreement with NI and pay all applicable NI license fees before engaging in such use.

As specified in each license, faculty, graduate students, post-doctoral students, and staff are permitted to install and license the software for instructional purposes or academic research purposes on their home or laptop computer.

The option to permit undergraduate students to install and activate software on their personal computers for learning purposes—referred to as the Student Install Option—is included with Academic Site License Teaching or Teaching and Research Small, Medium, and Large contracts that are active on the Standard Service Program (SSP). For a complete list of benefits and list of pricing options on the Standard Service Program (SSP), go to ni.com/info and enter the Info Code [AcademicSSP](#). Refer to the Student Install Option Licenses section for more information. Note that one year of SSP is included with the purchase of an Academic Site License.

7. Student Install Option Licenses

The option to permit undergraduate students to install and activate software on their personal computers for learning purposes is included with Academic Site License Teaching or Teaching and Research Small, Medium, and Large contracts that are active on the Standard Service Program (SSP) (ni.com/info, enter Info Code **AcademicSSP**). One year of SSP is included in the purchase of an Academic Site License and can be renewed each year. The number of student licenses included is tied to the size and boundary of your ASL contract.

The Student Install Option gives you access to all of the same software that is included in your ASL (ni.com/info, enter Info Code **ASLsoftware**). These are the three types of Student Install Options:

- **LabVIEW Student Install Option**—Included with the Academic Site License: LabVIEW Option. It activates LabVIEW and the vast majority of Toolkits and Modules for a wide array of engineering and scientific applications.
- **Multisim Student Install Option**—Included with the Academic Site License: Multisim Option. It activates Multisim, Ultiboard, and Multisim Live Premium for circuit design and simulation.
- **NI Student Install Option**—Included if you purchased both the LabVIEW and Multisim Academic Site Licenses. It activates all software covered by both ASL options.
