How to connect to "polito" WiFi network

1. Left click on "Network Connections" icon and select "polito".



2. Once connection established, open an internet browser and surf for any website.

4. Click on "LOGIN".


(*) - To use Politecnico di Torino WiFi, you need to complete the authentication procedure.

How to connect to "eduroam" WiFi network

1. Left click on "Network Connections" icon and select "eduroam".



2. Once connection established, enter your username and password according to Eduroam wifi **access policy**.
Note that your username is the same as "Portale della didattica" account.
